Lesson Objective:

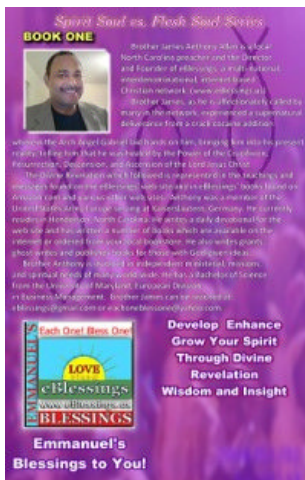

Lesson:

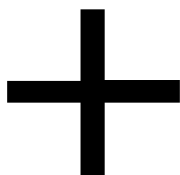
